

Guidelines and Submissions

Poets are encouraged to submit original poems from April 1–30. Poems will be judged in the following age groups:

- ◆ Children age 6-8
- ◆ Children age 9-11
- ◆ Teens age 12-14
- ◆ Teens age 15-18
- Adults

Guidelines

- 1. Poems must be your original work.
- 2. Only one entry per person.
- 3. The poem length should not exceed two (2) pages.
- 4. The poem should be authored by a single person.
- 5. Poems should be written with a general audience in mind.
- 6. Poems will not be returned to the entrant after the contest.
- 7. Poems without entry forms will not be considered for prizes.
- 8. Poets are not required to live in Dakota County.
- 9. Poets do not have to have a library card at the Dakota County Library.
- 10. Do not put your name on the page which contains the poem.
- 11. Staff and immediate family members of Dakota County Library staff are not eligible to apply.
- 12. Poems should be submitted in English, or be submitted along with English translation.

Entries may be emailed to *Holly.Carlson@co.dakota.mn.us*, or dropped off or mailed to any Dakota County Library or South St. Paul Library location by 11:59 pm on Monday, April 30, 2018.

Winning poets will be announced in May, and their poems will be published on the Dakota County Library website.

The top three poems in each age category will be awarded prizes. Winning poets must pick up their prizes at their local Dakota County Library within 30 days of notification.
